

Apprenticeship Standards



Initial Assessment:

All Apprentices will complete an initial assessment during induction of their English and Maths skills.

On programme training of Skills, Knowledge and Behaviours

End Point Assessment (EPA)

EPA is the last assessment an apprentice takes to confirm that they can do the job they have been training for and working towards. It is separate to all the other assessments an apprentice may need to do for their qualification.

Functional Skills: All Apprenticeships include English and Maths functional skills which provide further development in everyday

work related skills. Some Standards will also require the achievement of Functional Skills in Information, Communication and Technology (ICT).

Gateway: At the end of an apprenticeship, the apprentice will go through a 'gateway' process where they are signed-off by their employer as ready for a final assessment of their knowledge and practical capabilities.
